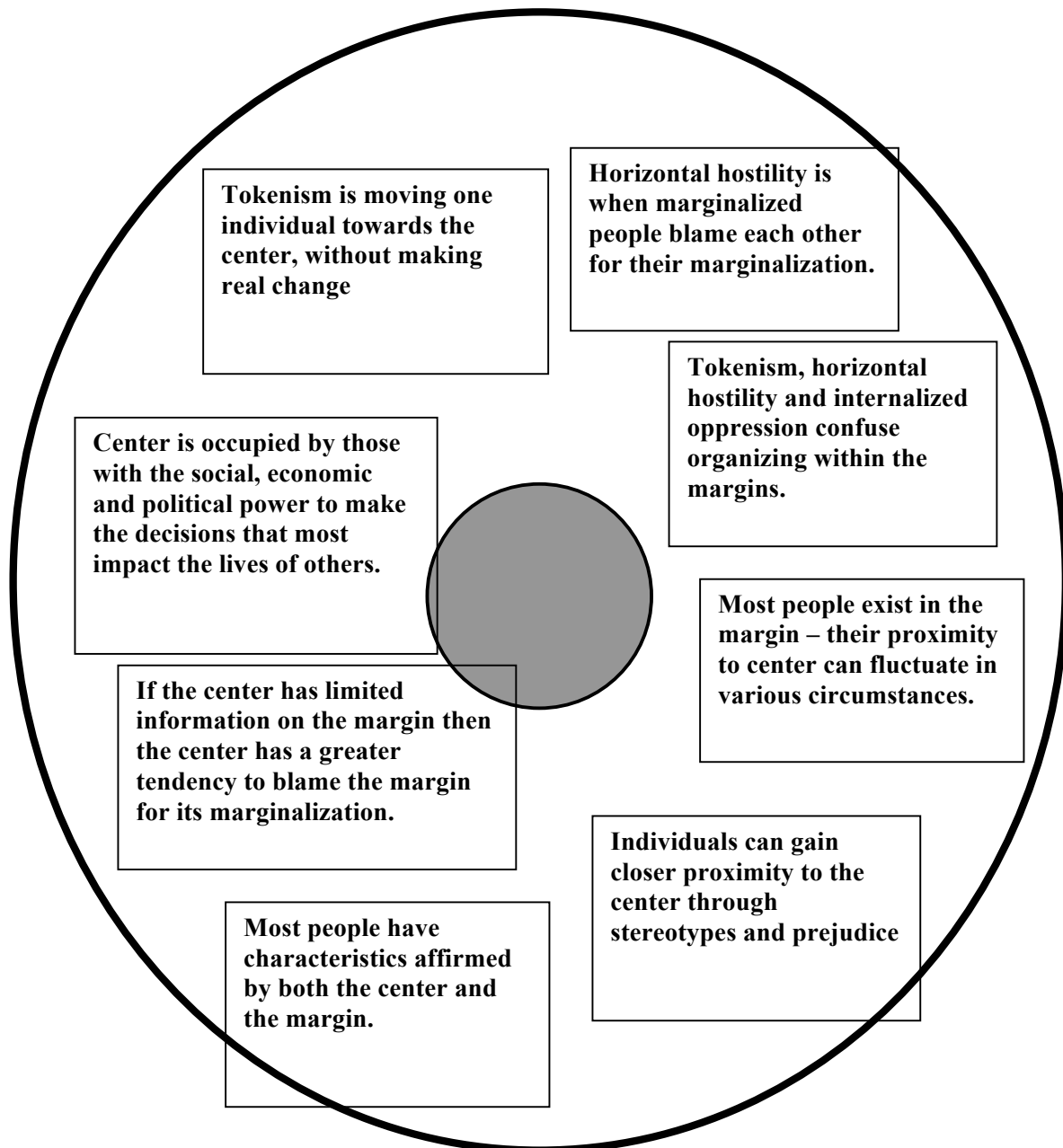


Margin/Center Social Arrangement

The Margin / Center Social Arrangement theory was developed by Beth Ritchie as a tool for analyzing, discussing and confronting the existence of unequal treatment in the U.S. The Margin / Center Social Arrangement is not intended to be a rigid model, it is intended to provide a common framework and language for challenging oppression. It serves to link institutional practices with individual experiences and provide a lens through which each of us can reflect on our own role in the social arrangement. The reality for most people is that we are navigating through a hostile environment, negotiating our proximity to the center on a daily basis.
